Similar to Make-A-Wish, it empowers foster children to envision a brighter future by offering personalized experiences, such as music lessons, bedroom makeovers, private tours, sporting events, and other meaningful gifts that celebrate their individuality and aspirations. With just one round underway in 2024, we aim to expand the program and offer even more foster children the chance to see their dreams come true in 2025.

FOSTER PARENT MENTORSHIP PROGRAM

The Mentorship Program pairs experienced foster parents ("mentors") with newly approved foster parents ("mentees") for a year-long term.

Mentors provide guidance, support, and resources, starting before or shortly after the mentee's first foster child placement.

By leveraging our mentors' lived experiences and building a strong support foundation, the program fosters lasting connections, ensures long-term success for both families and children in Oklahoma's foster care system, and helps retain foster families, ensuring more children have stable, nurturing homes.
